

INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

ABU has signed more than 90 cooperation agreements with universities in Russia, Kyrgyzstan, China, Turkey, Italy, UK, Poland, Bulgaria, Greece, France, etc., contributing to the University integration into the common educational space on the ground of the Bologna process principles.

TRAINING OF ABU STUDENTS IN FOREIGN UNIVERSITIES

Our University pays great attention to the development of students' academic mobility. Training during a semester or academic year in a foreign partner university allows students to significantly improve their professional and language competence. Moreover, students receive additional skills of social and intercultural adaptation in a foreign university.

At ABU, the following sources of funding are used to finance the students training on academic mobility programs:

1. Grant funding from the Kazakhstan Republic Ministry of Education and Science



In 2022-2024, Alikhan Bokeikhan University received grants from the Kazakhstan Republic Ministry of Education and Science to implement the academic mobility programs for Bachelor's and Master's students. In the framework of these programs, students had the opportunity to study for a semester at European universities. Students are paid all expenses associated with flight, accommodation, training, as well as visas and health insurance.

Within the framework of this program, more than 80 ABU students of various specialties were trained in two universities in Poland: Eastern European University of Applied Sciences and Bialystok Technical University, as well as two universities in Bulgaria: the Technical University of Sofia and New Bulgarian University. 1 Master's student completed his semester studies in France at the University of Paul Valerie Montpellier 3.

2. International programs funds (Erasmus +)

Every year Alikhan Bokeikhan University participates in Erasmus+ programs with European universities. Agreements on the implementation of academic mobility programs in the framework of Erasmus+ have been signed with universities in Poland and Bulgaria.

The main objective of Erasmus+ international student mobility programs is the higher education internationalization and young people cultural integration.

3. Funds of the University

ABU also implements students' academic mobility at Rector's grants expenses.

In 2023-2024 academic year, 3 students will be trained at University of Bialystok at specialties "Law inforcement" and "English with additional learning of a second foreign language" and at the Eastern European University within the "Finance" specialty.

4. Own funds of the students

At their own expense, students take part in various practices and internships in foreign universities, including summer language courses.





CENTER FOR KAZAKH LANGUAGE, CULTURE AND SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL INFORMATION EXCHANGE NAMED AFTER ABAI KUNANBAEV



On September 18, 2018, the opening ceremony of the "Center for Kazakh Language, Culture and Scientific and Technical Information Exchange named after Abai Kunanbaev" at the Technical University of Sofia took place.

The center was opened with the active support of the Kazakhstan Republic Embassy in the Republic of Bulgaria.

As a mission, Center aims to popularize Kazakh language and literature, promote cultural and spiritual values of the Kazakh people, as well as to develop researches for two universities, to implement cooperative research projects and programs of academic mobility.

The main activities of the Center:

- research on Kazakh language and literature, Kazakh people culture and traditions;
- development and publication of Kazakh language and literature teaching materials;
- **conducting cooperative research activities for students and teachers**;
- organization of foreign scientific internships for Bachelor's, Master's and PhD Kazakhstan students;
- * establishing partnerships with foreign universities, government structures and other organizations, aiming for scientific exchange in the areas of philology, literature, history, culture;
- scientific developments commercialization as a part of cooperative scientific projects of ABU and TU-Sofia.



CENTER FOR KAZAKH CULTURE AND INNOVATION NAMED AFTER ALIKHAN BOKEIKHAN

On November 28 2022, an online meeting with the St. Petersburg State Forestry Technical University administration took place. During the meeting both Universities signed the agreement opening the Center for Kazakh Culture and Innovation named after Alikhan Bokeikhan on the basis of SPbSFTU.

The outstanding politician and scientist Alikhan Bokeikhan studied at the Imperial Institute of Forestry and continuing the history of cooperation between universities, the administration decided to open the Center at SPbSFTU.



The mission of the Center is to popularize the cultural and spiritual values of the Kazakh people, as well as to promote the research activity between two universities, to implement cooperative academic and scientific projects.

The main activities of the Center are:

- promotion of Kazakh culture;
- conducting a complex of educational and cultural events popularizing the values of the Kazakh people;
- preparation and implementation of cooperative research projects;
- conducting cooperative scientific researches within the expertise areas of partner universities.

The main aim of these associations is to develop cooperation and activities coordination, namely, academic mobility programs for students, to promote joint two-degree programs and cooperative research projects.

THE ASSOCIATION OF ASIAN UNIVERSITIES

In May 2013, 28 universities along with ABU representing 8 Asian countries signed a Foundation Agreement on the establishment of the Association of Asian Universities in the Altai State University. The joint efforts of universities within the Association allowed elevating educational and scientific networking to a new level.

Serious improvements have been made to development and implement joint Master programs between members of the Association: Universities of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, China and Russia.



KAZAKHSTAN-BELARUS SCIENTIFIC AND EDUCATIONAL CONSORTIUM

In 2013, ABU joined the Kazakhstan-Belarus Scientific and Educational Consortium.

Kazakhstan-Belarusian Center of Scientific and Technical Cooperation (hereinafter - the Center) is a structural subdivision of "Eurasian National University named after L.N. Gumilyov". The Center structure includes The Center for the Belarusian Culture, Language and Literature researches.

The aim of the Center is to participate and organize activities contributing to the development of mutually beneficial cooperation between the Republic of Belarus and the Republic of Kazakhstan. There are 20 Kazakhstan and 21 Belarusian universities in the Kazakh-Belarus Scientific and Educational Consortium.



NOVOSIBIRSK INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR EDUCATION (NICE)

NOVOSIBIRSK INTERNATIONAL CENTER FOR EDUCATION

The center was established in 2001 as a non-profit partnership and operates on the basis of interuniversity agreements and Ministry of Education documents. Among the founders of the Center were universities of Novosibirsk and the Russian Council of Academic Mobility.

The main aim of the Center is to promote international universities relations in the Siberian region. Priority areas of the Center's activity are establishment and development of mutually beneficial contacts between Siberian and foreign educational institutions.

NICE has experience in organizing events on the expansion of international activities and internationalization of education.

At the suggestion of NICE and universities and supported by the administration of the Novosibirsk region, the International Cooperation Commission was established, with regular meetings of members.



ASSOCIATION OF ECONOMIC UNIVERSITIES OF SOUTH AND EASTERN EUROPE AND THE BLACK SEA REGION (ASECU YOUTH)

In 2019, ABU became a member of the ASECU Association.

ASECU Youth is a promising area of development of ASECU, an association of economists from 51 universities and research centers, which was founded in 2011.

Aims of the Association:



to promote cooperation between Economic Universities, Faculties and Departments, namely, to exchange views and information about syllabuses; to exchange students, as well as teaching and research staff;



to provide members with the opportunity to exchange information, opinions, etc. by publishing a scientific journal or by scientific studies collaboration aiming to improve the quality of education in the field of economic studies and business administration;





to take initiatives to protect the interests of members and their institutions, so that they are supported by international organizations and, in particular, by higher education institutions of the European Union;



to encourage cooperation between universities inside and outside the member-countries of the Association;



to continue cooperation in the field of higher education, improving relations with other organizations with similar goals, such as the EUA;



to provide opportunities for the universities faculties and departments degrees coordination;



to promote cooperation between economic universities, faculties, and departments in the researches to benefit the economy, society, peace and cultural development of the member-countries of the Association.



INTERNATIONAL SEMINARS WITH FOREIGN PARTNER UNIVERSITIES

On December 6-8, 2022, ABU held an international practical seminar "Psychological competence of a teacher: current technological issues for working with students", organized by the International Cooperation Department of ABU together with the Barnaul Institute of Psychology: Education and Human Development, in offline and online modes.



The speaker of the program: Olga Lyubimova, PhD, Associate Professor. Director of the Barnaul Institute of Psychology: Education and Human Development, the leading expert in the field of clinical and general psychology.

The main directions of the practical seminar:

- 1. Neuropsychological approach to learning difficulties in students;
- 2. Psychological and pedagogical conditions management of students educational motivation;
- 3. Methods of self-regulation in the professional activity of teachers and psychologists.



In the period of March 20- April 7, 2023, Alikhan Bokeikhan University successfully conducted a professional development program for the teaching staff, together with the Institute for Advanced Training of Financial Market Monitoring Center LLC (Novosibirsk, Russia).

March 20-30, the program "Management in Education" was held in a distant format, attended by professors and staff of ABU. The course aimed at improving the managerial competence of employees in the modern environment of the education system.

The main lecturer of the program: Nazarova Galina, Head of the Pedagogical Innovations Department of the Financial Market Monitoring Center; Associate Professor of the Financial Market and Financial Institutions Department in the Novosibirsk State Economics and Management University, a practicing trainer-facilitator.



Also, in the period of April 3-7, 2023, ABU hosted the program "**Digitalization Strategy in Education**", implemented in cooperation with the Institute for Advanced Training at the Financial Market Monitoring Center in offline format.
