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## **1. Explanatory note**

The modular educational program (MEP) is compiled in accordance with the provisions of the State Educational Standard of all levels of education, approved by order of the Minister of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 604 dated October 31, 2018, Standard rules for admission to training in educational organizations that implement educational programs of higher and postgraduate education under the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law", approved by order of the Minister of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 600 dated October 30, 2018, as well as on the basis of "Methodological recommendations for the development of modular educational programs for postgraduate education (doctoral studies in the scientific and pedagogical direction" MR 01.03 / 2018.

The modular educational program (MEP) is developed as a set and sequence of training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary to award the academic degree "Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Law" under the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law." The DB block includes disciplines of the university component (VC), which is 10 credits; and components of choice (CV), which is 15 credits. Modules of these disciplines make it possible to form a complex of key (research), general and professional competencies acquired by a graduate.

The PD block includes disciplines of the university component (VC), which is 18 credits; and an optional component (CV), which is 10 credits. The modules of these disciplines make it possible to form a complex of key and professional (developmental, creative, organizational and methodological) competencies acquired by the graduate.

ERWD – 115 credits;

FSA – 12 credits.

In total, a doctoral student at the end of the MEP must master 180 credits (100%).

In total, 6 modules were compiled for MEP.

To update OP 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law" on March 15, 2019 at the Faculty of Law, a round table was held on the topic "Labor market: state and ways of effective interaction", which was attended by representatives of the Prosecutor's Office of Semey city, law enforcement bodies, court, etc. At the end of the work, the participants of the round table adopted a resolution with a list of new disciplines for MNP that meet the requirements of the modern market. On the example of disciplines: "Conflictology and mediation in criminal proceedings", "Actual problems of intellectual property rights".

Objects of professional activity for the qualification of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in law under the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law" prepares qualified specialists who are ready to carry out scientifically grounded professional activities in jurisprudence to meet the staffing needs of law enforcement agencies, public authorities, judicial and law enforcement systems and organizations of all forms of ownership.

The goal of EP 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstan law" is coordinated with the development strategy of the university.

Thus, the goal of the EP 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law" is the preparation of competitive PHD doctors who possess scientific and creative thinking and scientific and theoretical skills to identify and solve urgent problems of legal science aimed at progressive

scientific, socio-economic, moral and cultural development of the state and society, which corresponds to the mission, goals of the university quality policy.

The mission of KazHUIU is the training of competitive personnel with higher and postgraduate education in a wide range of areas focused on the industrial and innovative development of the region

The category "competitiveness of graduates" is directly and closely related to the quality of EP and education in general.

To assess the achievement of the goal of the educational program, a graduate's competence model is formed in the modular educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law", which includes a list of competencies necessary for the effective implementation of professional activities.

The approved Graduate Model includes a description of the research tasks of the graduate, namely: demonstrating a systematic understanding of the field of study, mastery in terms of the skills and research methods used in this area; plan, develop, implement and adjust a complex research process, etc.

### **1. Competence model of a graduate**

In the modern world, the key resource for the economic growth of countries is their intellectual and educational potential. In this regard, the system of training highly qualified personnel is acquiring strategic importance, turning into the main instrument for ensuring the high competitiveness of the national economy.

The competitiveness of a modern worker is determined by his professional competence, broad social outlook, flexibility of behavior and a high level of individual activity. A developing society needs moral, enterprising people who can independently make decisions in a situation of choice, predicting their possible consequences, capable of cooperation, who are distinguished by mobility, dynamism, constructiveness, and have a developed sense of responsibility for the fate of their country.

The competence-based approach is the most important methodological tool for bringing the educational system of Kazakhstan closer to foreign education systems within the framework of the Bologna process. At present, it is generally accepted that the comparability of educational levels and qualifications of graduates can be achieved by comparing the educational results and competencies they acquired during their studies.

The competence-based approach implies profound systemic transformations affecting the content, teaching, learning, assessment, links of higher education with other levels of vocational education, the introduction of the European system of transfer and accumulation of credits and the application of the European framework for higher education qualifications.

A graduate of the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law" is awarded the academic degree "Doctor of Philosophy PhD in Law" is the formation of doctoral students with a high level of professional culture, including the culture of professional communication, with a civic position, capable of formulating and solving modern scientific and practical problems, teach in universities, successfully carry out research and scientific activities.

Doctor of Philosophy PhD in Law on the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law" should be prepared to carry out professional activities in legislative, executive and judicial authorities, in local governments, in organizations of various organizational and legal forms, in courts of general jurisdiction, in arbitration courts, notaries, in the legal profession, in the internal affairs bodies, in

the prosecutor's office, in the bodies executing punishment, in the customs authorities, as a lawyer in enterprises and organizations of various forms of ownership, law enforcement agencies, state and local government bodies, legal services enterprises, institutions, organizations.

**Competencies in the areas of professional activity of graduates of the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law":**

**1. General scientific competence:** form an awareness of the social significance of their future profession; a sufficient level of professional ethical self-awareness; skills in using the main provisions and methods of social, humanitarian and economic sciences in solving social and professional problems; new knowledge using modern educational and information technologies;

**2. Professional competence:**

the ability to skillfully apply normative legal acts in specific areas of legal activity, to implement the norms of substantive and procedural law in professional activities;

- the ability to perform official duties to ensure the rule of law and law and order, the safety of the individual, society, state;
- has the necessary depth of knowledge in the field of humanitarian and socio-economic disciplines, corresponding to the implementation of his professional activities;
- owns the basics of scientific analysis and forecasting of various phenomena and processes, is able to carry out their qualitative and quantitative analysis, is able to determine the goals of social research and use the methods of the studied sciences for their implementation, readiness to work on interdisciplinary projects;
- logically sets out the acquired knowledge, demonstrates the ability to apply the acquired knowledge in practice, understands and uses the methods of critical analysis, legal technique, interpretation and application of regulatory legal acts;
- finds the best ways to obtain the necessary legal information and is able to process it using modern technologies;
- develops legal documents, carries out legal expertise of regulatory legal acts and other documents;
- provides qualified legal opinions and advice;
- makes legal decisions and performs other legal actions in strict accordance with the legislation;
- have an awareness of the social significance of their future profession, manifestation of intolerance to corrupt behavior, respect for law and law, has a sufficient level of legal awareness;
- the ability to professionally conduct scientific research in the field of law;
- -skills of using the basic provisions and methods of social, humanitarian and economic sciences in solving social and professional problems; new knowledge using modern educational and information technologies; the ability to improve and develop their intellectual and general cultural level.
- takes the necessary measures to restore violated rights.

**The result of mastering** the program of the professional module is the mastering by the students of the type of scientific and professional activity in the field of jurisprudence, including professional (PC) and general (GC) competencies:

- Adapt the knowledge gained when solving problems of interpersonal and professional interaction, demonstrating mastery of the culture of written and oral speech, the ability to debate and defend one's position reasonably;

- Criticize the analytical data of the market and business processes, using the latest knowledge with the subsequent reconstruction of the changes proposed by the students;
- Able to apply in practice scientific discoveries and developments, legal norms for the protection of intellectual property;
- Able to plan and predict further professional development;
- Able to plan, coordinate, organize, implement the process of scientific research, based on the synthesis and analysis of new scientific ideas, methodological and technological approaches;
- Able to generate new knowledge, develop innovative programs, applied, industry and interdisciplinary research;
- Able to analyze and process information from various sources, develop hypotheses based on the information received, evaluate development strategies in the context of sustainable development of the region and offer science-based solutions;
- Able to conduct independent scientific research, characterized by academic integrity, based on the analysis of modern theories and methods;
- Able to generate and consolidate their own scientific ideas and concepts, respond to criticism, defend them in front of the scientific community, expanding the boundaries of scientific knowledge and contributing to the social, economic and cultural development of the region;
- Able to classify and group the obtained data, followed by their critical analysis, and making a public report on the results, incl. in a foreign language, before the scientific community at scientific forums, conferences, seminars at both international and national levels;
- Able to transform the acquired knowledge into practical activity;
- Modifies the knowledge gained, creates a plan for conducting an experiment and other actions, followed by an explanation of the facts, rules and principles and the implementation of the results in production (educational process).

**Requirements for special competencies of a doctoral student in the educational program 8D04208 - "Modern trends in the development of Kazakhstani law»:**
