CERTIFICATE GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS

By Order No. 86 of 27 December 2023, the University launched the Sustainable Development Committee, the main objectives of which are: to contribute to the implementation of sustainable development goals by conducting scientific research in the field of environmental protection, as well as environmental education and upbringing, contributing to the assimilation of a number of environmental and ethical norms, values, and professional skills; to modernise and optimise the educational and research process on environmental protection and sustainable development at the university. The issue of monitoring the amount of greenhouse gas emissions and achieving "zero" emissions is also one of the key issues supervised by this committee.

The Ministry of Energy of the Republic of Kazakhstan determines the circle of persons submitting the report on greenhouse gas inventory. These persons are natural resource users operating in oil and gas, energy, mining and metallurgical, chemical industries, agriculture and transport, whose greenhouse gas emissions exceed the equivalent of twenty thousand tonnes of carbon dioxide per year. Therefore, the Educational Institution "Alikhan Bokeikhan University", carrying out educational activities and not exceeding the limit of greenhouse gas emissions per year, is not obliged to provide relevant reporting to the competent authority.

Nevertheless, we are committed to making our university more transparent and responsible about its environmental impact. We are actively working to reduce our emissions of carbon dioxide and other harmful substances, introduce energy efficient technologies, conduct eco-education activities and engage students and staff in sustainable consumption and production. In the near future, we plan to implement mechanisms for reporting on environmental performance, including greenhouse gas emissions, to confirm our commitment to sustainable development and environmental protection.

In addition, it is important to note the fact that the university does not currently have equipment and systems that allow for greenhouse gas emissions.
