Information about updating educational programs Faculty of Law for the 2024-2025 academic year

The basis for updating the educational program 6B04220 "Jurisprudence"

The following changes have been made for the 2024-2025 academic year:

- 1. In accordance with the Interuniversity Standard on the Use of artificial Intelligence in higher and postgraduate education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the content of the discipline "Electronic evidence in criminal proceedings" has been amended, which has affected ON 7.
- 2. In the disciplines of the university component of the OOD block, the integrated program "Fundamentals of Economic and Legal Knowledge" includes topics on studying the basics of financial literacy, respectively, changes were made to ON 1.

Thus, changes were made to 2 disciplines, which is 3.2% of the total number of disciplines, 2 learning outcomes were changed, which is 13.3%.

The basis for updating the educational program 6B04221 "Civil Service and judicial system"

For the 2024-2025 academic year, the following changes have been made:

- 1. In accordance with the Interuniversity Standard on the use of artificial intelligence in higher and postgraduate education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the content of the discipline "Web Law" has been amended, which has affected ON13.
- 2. In the disciplines of the university component of the OOD block, the integrated program "Fundamentals of Economic and Legal Knowledge" includes topics on the study of the basics of financial literacy, respectively, changes were made to ON 1.

Thus, changes were made to 2 disciplines, which is 3.2% of the total number of disciplines, 2 learning outcomes were changed, which is 13.3%.

The basis for updating the educational program 6B04222 "Investigative and prosecutorial activities"

The following changes have been made for the 2024-2025 academic year:

- 1. In accordance with the Interuniversity Standard on the use of artificial Intelligence in higher and postgraduate education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, changes were made in the discipline "Digitalization of pre-trial investigation" at the level of learning outcomes, which affected ON 12.
- 2. In the disciplines of the university component of the OOD block, topics on the study of the basics were introduced into the integrated program "Fundamentals of Economic and Legal Knowledge". financial literacy, respectively, changes have been made to ON 4

3. ACCORDING to the recommendations of the social partners, the discipline "Public service and the basics of local self-government" was introduced.

Thus, changes were made to 3 disciplines (which is 5.17% of the total number of disciplines), 2 learning outcomes were changed, which is 15.4%.

The basis for updating the educational program 6B12330 "Law enforcement"

The following changes have been made for the 2024-2025 academic year:

- 1. In accordance with the Interuniversity Standard on the use of artificial intelligence in higher and postgraduate education of the Republic of Kazakhstan, changes were made to the content of the discipline "Methods of investigation of cybercrime", which affected ON 9.13.
- 2. In the disciplines of the university component of the OOD block, topics on the study of the basics of financial literacy were introduced into the integrated program "Fundamentals of Economic and Legal Knowledge", Accordingly, changes have been made to ON 4.
- 3. Based on the Atlas of New Professions (Cyber Researcher), new disciplines have been introduced: "Pre-trial investigation in electronic format"; "Activities of pre-trial investigation bodies", "Criminological foundations of cybersecurity", "Investigation of man-made disasters", "Interaction of preliminary investigation and inquiry bodies in the investigation of a man-made crime", which was reflected in ON8,9, 10,13, 14.
- 4. According to the recommendations of the social partners, the disciplines "Administrative Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan" and "Civil Service and fundamentals of local self-government" were introduced.

Thus, changes were made in 8 disciplines (which is 13.8% of the total number of disciplines), 6 learning outcomes were changed, which is 40%.
