The developments present an analysis of the current state of legislation and propose ways to integrate digital rights into the country's legal system. The practical significance of proposals for improving legal regulation in the context of digitalization and ensuring the protection of citizens' rights in the digital space is substantiated. Also, as part of the implementation of this section, a trip to Wismar (Germany) was carried out: Wismar University of Applied Sciences Technology, Business and Design. As part of the business trip, a series of meetings were held with experts and authorities, best practices for the implementation of digital rights in German legislation and their integration into the legal system were studied. The knowledge and experience gained were used to develop recommendations for improving the national legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the field of digital rights.
