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I. EXPLANATORY NOTE

The modular educational program (MEP) was developed by:

- based on the State Standard of Higher and Postgraduate Education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;
- in accordance with the Rules for organizing the educational process using credit technology of education, approved by the order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;
- in accordance with the Model Rules for the activities of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by the order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;
- in accordance with the Professional Standard "Teacher", approved by the order of the Acting Minister of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated 12/15/2022 No. 500.
- in accordance with the approved structure of the MOP;
- taking into account the recommendations of employers.

The modular educational program is developed as a set of sequential educational modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for obtaining the degree of "Bachelor of Education in the educational program 6B01707 - "Kazakh Language and Literature".

In the modules of the block of general educational disciplines (GED) (total 56 credits, of which OK (compulsory component) - 51 credits, university component (UC - 5 credits) includes disciplines common to all educational programs, during the study of which the graduate must master knowledge of the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, information about the political and economic life of the country.

The block of basic disciplines (BD) (total 112 credits) includes disciplines of the university component (VC - 39 credits) and components of choice (EC - 73 credits). Modules of these disciplines form basic and professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and abilities in theoretical and industry sciences in the field of education .

The block of core disciplines of the PD (64 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (VC - 30 credits) and elective components (EC - 34 credits). The modules of these disciplines cover the basic and special competencies that a graduate must possess: the formation of professional quality, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as a

sequence of disciplines, including the theoretical and practical significance of issues of the Kazakh language and literature, methods of teaching the Kazakh language and literature.

The criterion for completion of the educational process is the student's mastery of at least 240 credits .

The MOP consists of 20 modules.

The goal of the educational program 6B01707 - "Kazakh language and literature":

Training competitive specialists who have received high-quality professional comprehensive education in the field of Kazakh language and literature, who are able to work effectively for the benefit of society and the state, who possess intercultural and communicative competencies and use information technologies in pedagogical activities.

Expected results of the educational program 6B01707 – "Kazakh language and literature":

ON1: Planning and conducting training courses on the subjects of Kazakh language and literature, traditional and innovative technologies; familiarization with new achievements in psychology, pedagogy and philological sciences, the basics of teaching methods, the use of modern information technologies in education. Providing feedback to students using digital technologies, including artificial intelligence.

ON2: Understand the basic theoretical principles of the Kazakh language and use this knowledge to achieve results, be able to carry out linguistic analysis.

ON3: Apply appropriate teaching methods and assessment tools taking into account the acquired scientific and theoretical knowledge of the Kazakh language, the characteristics and needs of students, plan professional development independently. Provide feedback to students using digital technologies, including artificial intelligence.

In order to create special conditions for obtaining education for individuals with special educational needs, the graduate's competency model is supplemented by professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. For this purpose, courses are introduced into the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor" to develop the ability of individuals with special educational needs to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease.
