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1. EXPLANATORY NOTE

Educational Program (OP) "6B01733-Russian Language and Literature in schools with Russian and Non-Russian languages of instruction (IP) – is an innovative teacher education program for teachers who want to specialize in teaching Russian language and literature in educational institutions (schools, colleges, gymnasiums).

This educational program (OP) is a national educational program for teacher training, which was developed by the Karagandam Statem Universityom named after E. A. Buketov in cooperation with Pavlodar Pedagogical University, Abai Kazakh National Pedagogical University, Aktobe Regional University named after K. Zhubanov, North Kazakhstan University named after M. Kozybayev, Arkalyk Pedagogical Institute named after A. A. Abai, and others.

The special feature of this OP is that it combines two educational programs - "Russian Language and Literature" and "Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction", which is due to the needs of the educational services market, namely, the need to train teachers who can be flexible in a rapidly changing world.

The future specialist will have universal (general professional and subject-specific) competencies necessary for teaching regardless of the number of students and the organization of education: in small-class schools, in schools with Russian and non-Russian language of instruction, in schools with hybrid (mixed) education.

OP provides equal opportunities for learning, without infringing on the rights and interests of future teachers, while maintaining the principles of equality, respect, and tolerance. By its nature, it is interdisciplinary, focused on future teachers, scientifically integrated and problem-oriented, and the choice of courses is determined by current problems of history and society and also corresponds to international course descriptors.

The EP is based on the principles of constructive alignment, where teaching and evaluation methods, as well as subject courses, are chosen in such a way as to ensure the achievement and measurement of the competencies outlined in the EP. The EP also follows an inclusive approach, taking into account the multi-ethnic and multi-faith composition of prospective teachers and their diverse learning support needs.

The modular educational program is designed as a set of consecutive training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the

competencies necessary for awarding the academic degree of Bachelor of Education in the educational program 6B01733-Russian Language and Literature in schools with Russian and non-Russian languages of instruction (IP)

The modules of the block of general education subjects (GED) (a total of 56 credits, including CC (mandatory component) – 51 credits, UC (university component) – 5 credits) include disciplines common to all educational programs, in the study of which the graduate must master the competence of general education, which is aimed at knowledge of the laws of development of society and society. its socio-political and legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of computer science, language communication and understanding the principles of a healthy lifestyle, knowledge of information about the political life of the country.

The block of basic subjects (BS) (a total 109 credits) includes subjects of the university component (UC-95 credits) and elective components (EC-14 credits). Modules of these disciplines form general professional competencies aimed at developing basic and professional qualities that cover deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills навыки in theoretical and branch sciences in the field of education.

The block of profile disciplines of PD (total6-7 credits) includes disciplines of the university component (UC-15 credits) and elective components (EC-52 credit). Modules of these disciplines allow graduates to develop special competencies aimed at the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve pedagogical problems of a theoretical and practical nature in the field of education and upbringing.

Additional types of training (ATT) include B себя final certification.

The criterion of completion of the educational process is the student's completion of 240 credits, including 232 credits of 32 theoretical training and 8 credits – of final certification.

The MEP consists of 15 modules.

Purpose of the educational program 6B01733 - "Russian language and literature in schools with Russian and non-Russian languages of instruction (IP): The educational program is aimed at training a specialist who is able to carry out professional activities as a teacher of Russian language and Russian literature in secondary education organizations of all types and types, regardless of the language of instruction (Russian and non-Russian languages).

Expected results of the educational program:

- ON 1: Develops, implements, evaluates and develops learning and leadership processes in various types of educational environments in a pedagogically meaningful way, and is able to use various digital resources, including artificial intelligence.
- **ON 2:** Communicates constructively in various interactive multicultural relationships and communities. Creates texts of different genres and styles, taking into account the culture of pedagogical communication, speech conflictology, and audience profile. Applies the rules of rhetoric in real speech practice.
- **ON 3:** Ready to critically evaluate their values, attitudes, ethical principles and working methods, able to set new goals for their own pedagogical development, the development of their organization and professional well-being.
- **ON 4:** Performs a comparative analysis of grammatical systems, classifies language phenomena of the Russian and Kazakh languages, performs a qualified historical commentary on the facts of the Russian language.
- ON 5: Applies knowledge about the modern Russian literary language as a system (phonetics, vocabulary, grammar), about the rules of functioning of Russian language units in speech. He knows the history of the modern Russian language and its place in world culture and science. It is able to qualify various language phenomena, determine the system connections of language units and their functions.
- ON 6: Speaks Russian in its literary form, in various types of speech activities necessary for successful communication (speaking, listening, writing, reading), in all forms and types of communication, including virtual communication. Knows the norms of Russian speech, style and genre diversity. He is able to make the right choiceof linguistic environments inaccordance with the norms of the Russian literary language, in different situations, taking into account

different social and stylistic contexts.

- **ON 7:** Applies knowledge of the main provisions and concepts in the field of literary theory, the history of the development of Russian and world literature, its periodization, the current state and place in world culture. Able to interpret and conduct literary analysis of literary texts. He is able to choose a reading strategy, extract valuable information and use it in his own experience, in various socio-cultural situations.
- **ON 8:** Has advanced methodological tools for teaching Russian language and literature and is capable of designing and implementing the process of teaching Russian language and Russian literature in schools with Russian and non-Russian languages of instruction.
- **ON 9**: Is able to use special approaches to learning in order to include all students, including those with special educational needs, in the educational process.
- **ON 10:** Has system linguistic knowledge that includes the main levels of language functioning. He has practical skills of qualified linguistic analysis of words, sentences, and texts in synchronic and diachronic aspects, taking into account sociolinguistic and psycholinguistic factors.
- **ON 11:** Demonstrates research and knowledge management skills in the field of Russian linguistics and literary studies (analysis, processing, systematization of information; modeling, forecasting, design of scientific activities). Able to carry out research activities in the field of Russian philology, including directing the research work of students.

For this purpose, the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor" introduces courses for developing the ability of individuals with special educational needs to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease.
