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1. EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Modular Educational Program (MEP) is compiled by:

- on the basis of the State Compulsory Standard of Higher Education, approved by order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 604 dated October 31, 2018;
- in accordance with the Rules for organizing the educational process on credit technology of education;
- in accordance with the Professional Standard "Teacher" (Appendix to the order of the Chairman of the Board of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken" No. 133 dated June 8, 2017);
- in accordance with the approved structure of the MEP;
- also taking into account the recommendations of employers - teachers of the English language, expressed by them at seminars - round tables on the quality of education and employment issues, with the participation of employers (KSU "Secondary School No. 38", KSU "Secondary School No. 22"). As a result, the following disciplines of the methodological block were added to the MEP: 1) IT in foreign language education, 2) Methods of foreign language teaching in the context of inclusive education, 3) Communicative methodology of teaching foreign languages, 4) Critical thinking technologies, as well as theoretical and linguistic disciplines: 1) Cognitive linguistics, 2) Fundamentals of the scientific style of speech, 3) English in communication, 4) Academic reading and writing.

The modular educational program is developed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for the assignment of an academic bachelor's degree in the Educational program 6B01708 "English with additional learning of a second foreign language".

The modules of the block of general education disciplines (GED) (56 credits in total, of which CC (compulsory component) - 51 credits, CCh (components by choice) - 5 credits) include disciplines common to all educational programs, in the study of which the graduate must master the following competencies: knowledge of the laws of the development of society and its socio-political, legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of informatics, linguistic communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, knowledge of the political life of the country.

The block of basic disciplines (BD) (112 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (UC - 48 credits) and components by choice (CCh - 64 credits). The modules of these disciplines form a complex of competencies: the formation of basic and professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills in theoretical and industrial sciences in the field of education.

The block of profiling disciplines (PD) (60 credits in total) includes the disciplines of the university component (UK - 15 credits) and components by choice (CCh - 45 credits). The modules of these disciplines make it possible to form a complex of key and special competencies acquired by a graduate: the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve pedagogical problems of a theoretical and practical nature in the field of education and upbringing.

Awarded degree: the bachelor of education on educational program 6B01708 "English with additional learning of a second foreign language"

Sphere of professional activity:

The bachelor carries out his professional activities in the field of foreign language education in the field of secondary general education, within the framework of which the development of the personality is ensured by means of a foreign language.

Objects of professional activity:

- Secondary comprehensive schools,
- Specialized schools with in-depth study of foreign languages,
- Language training centers,
- Foreign companies,
- Organizations cooperating with foreign companies and investors.

Professional subjects

The subjects of professional activity of a bachelor of the designated educational program are:

- organization of the educational process in the basic main foreign language;
- organization of the educational process in the language for special purposes;
- organization of the educational process in the language for academic purposes;
- organization of the educational process in the second foreign language.

Professional activities:

The bachelor of education in the educational program 6B01708 "English with additional learning of a second foreign language (German, Turkish)" can perform the following types of professional activities:

- educational (pedagogical): performing the functions of a teacher of two foreign languages, taking into account the international standard level requirements for the formation of foreign language competencies of students;
- experimental research: the study of scientific and methodological literature, familiarization with the advanced experience of foreign language education, its generalization, conducting experiments with the implementation of their results in the educational process;
- organizational and managerial: planning the content of foreign language education at different levels; determination of ways of organizing and conducting the educational process; management and monitoring of the quality of the formation of foreign language competencies;
- socio-pedagogical: the formation of a multicultural personality with a developed worldview and thinking;
- educational: the implementation of educational work in accordance with the laws, patterns, principles, with the educational mechanisms of the pedagogical process; the formation of the ability to plan extracurricular educational work, to determine and solve specific educational tasks, to choose

and use various forms and methods of upbringing and teaching schoolchildren; building relationships with the student body, teachers working in a given class, with parents; develop your own approaches to the process of teaching and upbringing;

- educational and technological: information literacy; possession and use in the educational process of the latest technologies (including multimedia means of teaching foreign languages.).

Functions of professional and pedagogical activity

The bachelor must master the functions of professional and pedagogical activity focused on the personality of the student:

- the functions of goal-setting, including: communicative-teaching, educating, developing functions;
- operational and structural functions: gnostic (research), constructive planning, organizational.

Areas of professional and pedagogical activity.

The main directions of the professional and pedagogical activity of a teacher of two foreign languages of a secondary school according to his main and specialized qualifications are:

- organization of the educational process of teaching foreign languages in the classes of a basic, specialized school, in a school with in-depth study of foreign languages (including teaching a number of subjects in a foreign language);
- carrying out extracurricular activities in a foreign language;
- implementation of educational work by means of a foreign language;
- educational and pedagogical activity in the system of the integral pedagogical process of the school;
- improving their professional and pedagogical qualifications; possession of the latest information technologies.

The content of professional and pedagogical activity consists of the following professionally significant skills of a teacher of foreign languages:

- pedagogically, psychologically and methodologically correctly to carry out professional activities aimed at the formation of trainees of the traits of a secondary linguistic personality, capable of reflecting the foreign picture of the world by means of the language being studied;
- to study the individual characteristics of the personality of students;
- possess the skills of self-reflection and the formation of reflexive skills in schoolchildren;
- to plan their own professional actions, taking into account modern requirements for the organization of the educational process and on the basis of objective laws of mastering the foreign languages being taught; select authentic materials, including regional and cultural studies, and methodically interpret them;
- to organize foreign language communication in the lesson, using creative, interactive forms of student work;
- to create a favorable psychological climate in the lesson, which promotes the disclosure of the individual capabilities of each student and stimulates the development of the emotional sphere of the student's personality, his creative, cognitive and linguistic abilities, the ability to socially interact with others;
- use a control and corrective mechanism that meets the requirements of the international standard.

2. COMPETENCE MODEL OF THE GRADUATE

Upon graduation, the graduate is able to:

- have a general idea about the world as a whole, its categorical structure, about a person and the society in which he lives, about the ways of human activity or mastering the world;
- cultural, historical, social, political and economic features of the development of society;
- traditions and cultures of the peoples of Kazakhstan;
- the foundations of the legal system and legislation of Kazakhstan (also in the field of human rights, for example, international normative legal acts, legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan in the field of education and protection from childhood, etc.)

To do this, the graduate must have:

- uses innovative teaching technologies, incl. ICT, critical thinking technologies;
- conducts standard training sessions on foreign language, using didactic knowledge in integration with knowledge in a special area;
- plans training sessions on foreign language, taking into account the principles of integration and continuity of teaching at all levels of secondary education;
- finds non-standard and alternative solutions, be able to generate new pedagogical ideas, to think critically.

- new achievements in the field of psychological and pedagogical sciences;
- traditional technologies and didactic means, including ICT;
- features of the psychology of adolescent children;
- pedagogical technologies of differentiated and integrated learning, developmental learning, features and specifics of the competence-based approach in teaching foreign languages;

- principles and methods of formation of communicative, informational, professional competencies of students;
- methods of pedagogical goal-setting for the design of new models and strategies of the educational process.

2) Labor function: educational

Upon graduation, the graduate is able to:

- Build the educational process, observing the pedagogical tact, showing respect for the personality of students and adherence to the system of universal and national values in their unity, as well as to resist any types of discrimination and extremism.
- To develop a favorable educational environment for the realization of the cultural and linguistic needs of students; to form a tolerant attitude of students to a different culture, to a different way of life.

To do this, the graduate must have:

- shows adherence to the highest social values, to the ideas of humanistic pedagogy;

- builds the educational process taking into account the national priorities of Kazakhstan;
- shows the ability to resist any kind of discrimination, extremism;
- develops cultural awareness, language competence;
- contributes to the development of a favorable educational environment for the realization of the cultural and linguistic needs of students;
- forms a tolerant attitude to a different culture, to a different way of life.

- educational psychology;

- educational potential of academic subjects;
- principles of integrating the content of education with the national values of Independent Kazakhstan

- develops training materials on FL in accordance with the assigned objectives of the classes and in accordance with the instructions and requirements;

- ways to implement individual plans for professional development;
- principles and methods of constructing situational pedagogical tasks;
- principles and methods for the development of educational and program documentation;
- regulatory and legal documents in the field of education.

2) **Labor function: research**

Upon graduation, the graduate is able to:

- Explore the educational environment, educational practice, using the results of diagnostics of the individual characteristics of students; to identify the needs and difficulties in the training of foreign languages.
- Search, structure and systematize psychological and pedagogical knowledge, be capable of systemic thinking and holistic perception of pedagogical activity.
- Conduct scientific research; independently acquire and use new knowledge and skills in research and practice, expand and deepen their own scientific competence.

To do this, the graduate must have:

Skills and abilities:

- uses the results of diagnostics of individual characteristics of students;
- identifies the needs and difficulties in training a foreign language;
- uses methods of joint reflection with colleagues in the context of research practice; plans and conducts research on the educational environment;
- possesses the skills of searching, formalizing, structuring and systematizing psychological, pedagogical and methodological knowledge;
- formalizes the results of his research into a written scientific text in accordance with the general laws of the lexical and grammatical system of scientific speech and the existing requirements of regulatory documents.

Knowledge:

- principles and methods of research of the educational environment, research of educational practice;
- research methods in pedagogy and methods of foreign language education;
- methods of psychological and pedagogical tracking of students' activities;
- organization of the process of conducting and the basic principles of building a scientific research;
- procedures for the preparation and defense of the thesis (project);
- principles and culture of academic integrity.

3) **Labor function: social and communicative**

Upon graduation, the graduate is able to:

- Be proficient in Kazakh, Russian, foreign languages; skills of constructive dialogue, communication in a multicultural, multi-ethnic and multi-confessional society.
- Possess communication strategies and tactics, language norms and techniques adopted in oral and written communication; to use them adequately in solving problems and professional tasks.

To do this, the graduate must have:

Skills and abilities:

- to implement the skills of foreign language communication in the context of business and professional communication, as well as in the framework of academic discourse;
- constructive dialogue, communication in a multicultural, multi-ethnic and multi-confessional society.

Knowledge:

- national, historical, cultural, regional, linguistic features of the studied linguistic phenomena and realities;
- basic grammatical and lexical phenomena, the rules of speech etiquette characteristic of the English language in the field of professional, business and intercultural communication.

To create special conditions for people with special educational needs to receive education, the competence model of a graduate is complemented by professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. To this end, the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor" includes courses for the formation of people with special educational needs of the ability to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease.
