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1. EXPLANATORY NOTE

Modular educational program (MEP) is compiled in accordance with the following regulatory documents :

- on the basis of the State Standard of Higher and Postgraduate Education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;

- in accordance with the Rules for organizing the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;

- in accordance with the Model rules for the activities of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;

- in accordance with the Professional standard "Teacher", approved by the Deputy Chairman of the Board of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken" dated June 8, 2017. No. 133;

- in accordance with the approved structure of the MEP (edition No. 4 of 05.10.2022);

The modular educational program is developed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for the assignment of an academic bachelor's degree in the educational program 6B01732 "Russian Language and Literature in Schools with a Non-Russian Language of Instruction".

The modules of the block of general education disciplines (GED) (a total of 56 credits, of which OK (mandatory component) - 51 credits, EC (optional component) - 5 credits) include disciplines common to all educational programs, in the study of which the graduate must master the competence general education, which is aimed at knowing the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the foundations of computer science, language communication and understanding the principles of a healthy lifestyle, possession of information about the political life of the country.

The block of basic disciplines (BD) (112 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (UC - 39 credits) and elective components (EC - 73 credits). The modules of these disciplines form general professional competencies aimed at developing basic and professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills in theoretical and sectoral sciences in the field of education .

The block of major disciplines of the MD (60 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (UC - 25 credits) and elective components (EC - 35 credits). The modules of these disciplines allow graduates to form special competencies aimed at the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills and abilities for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve pedagogical problems of a theoretical and practical nature in the field of education and upbringing.

Additional types of education (ATE) include final certification.

The criterion for the completion of the educational process is the development of 240 credits by a student, of which 228 credits are theoretical training and 12 credits are final certification.

The modular educational program consists of 20 modules .

The purpose of the educational program 6B01732 "Russian language and literature in schools with non-Russian language of instruction" : training of competitive specialists - teachers of the Russian language and literature with fundamental knowledge, skills and competencies in the field of pedagogy, psychology, methods of teaching the Russian language and literature, necessary in professional activities at the level recognized by the international community, and meeting the needs of the society of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Expected results of the educational program:

ON 1: Plan, design and conduct training sessions in the Russian language and literature, integrating knowledge from various subject areas in solving pedagogical problems, develop educational materials in the Russian language and literature using traditional, innovative, information and communication technologies, as well as new achievements in the field of psychological and pedagogical sciences.

ON 2: To form and develop the language, communicative, information, professional competencies of students; know the functional features of oral and written professionally oriented texts, including those of a scientific and technical nature; recognize and use in oral and written statements the basic grammatical units characteristic of professional speech; to carry out foreign language communication within the framework of professional communication.

ON 3: To carry out the educational process, observing the pedagogical tact and create a favorable educational environment that helps to strengthen the feeling of patriotism, the formation of a tolerant attitude of students to a different culture, to the democratic values of modern society.

ON 4: Know the main typologically relevant parameters of the Russian language; be able to describe the features of the Russian language against the background of other Slavic, Indo-European languages and the languages of the world as a whole; be aware of the diversity of language varieties (literary norm, dialects, vernacular, colloquial speech) and identify grammatical elements of various subsystems in the text; own modern scientific methods of language analysis and methods of describing phonetics, morphology, syntax, lexicology of the Russian language, as well as the pragmatics of using language tools;

ON 5: Apply the skills of conducting a constructive dialogue that meets the standards of the modern Russian literary language, communication in a multicultural, multi-ethnic and multi-confessional society using the real life experience of students;

ON 6: Comply with the norms of business ethics, find compromises when working in a team and adequately navigate in various social situations, based on the forms and methods of cooperation in the professional community and interaction with various social groups, initiate innovative ideas that unite the stakeholders of education, and involve them in educational process;

To create special conditions for people with special educational needs to receive education, the competence model of a graduate is complemented by professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. To this end, the catalog of courses of the additional educational program " Minor " includes courses for the formation of people with special educational needs of the ability to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease.
