1.Explanatory note on the educational program 6B02212 - "Domestic and world history"

The Modular Educational program (MEP) is compiled in accordance with:

- The State standard of higher and Postgraduate education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;
- Rules for the organization of the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;
- Standard rules of activity of educational organizations implementing educational programs of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by the Order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 595 dated 30.10.2018;
- Form 26 Structure of the modular educational program (Revision No. 3 of 08.10.2021).

The modules of the GS block (51 credits) and elective components (5 credits) are aimed at forming the ideological, civil and moral positions of the future specialist, competitive on the basis of knowledge of information and communication technologies, building communication programs in Kazakh, Russian and foreign languages, develop the ability to interpersonal social and professional communication in Kazakh, Russian and foreign languages; contribute to the development of information literacy through the mastery and use of modern information and communication technologies in all spheres of their lives and activities; form a personality capable of mobility in the modern world, critical thinking and physical self-improvement, the formation of knowledge among students in the field of economics and law, the basics of anti-corruption culture, ecology and life safety, as well as entrepreneurship skills.

The BD block includes disciplines of the university component and practice – 47 credits and elective components - 65 credits. Modules of these disciplines form a complex of knowledge covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and skills in historical, theoretical and branch sciences.

The Profile disciplines block includes disciplines of the university component – 25 credits and elective components - 35 credits. Modules of these disciplines allow you to form a complex of knowledge, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze historical problems, for successful problem solving.

The total number of credits upon completion of the educational program 6B02212 " Domestic and World History " is 240 credits. The MEP consists of 23 modules.

The purpose of the educational program 6B02212 " Domestic and world history " - Preparation of competitive graduates in the labor market who possess the basics of pedagogical and research work, are able to solve professional tasks, form ideas about historical stages, historiography and the source of national and world history, historical stages of ethnic, political, socio-economic and cultural development through in-depth study of national and world history.

Expected results of the educational program 6B02212 Domestic and world history

ON1 Understand the importance of the principles and culture of academic integrity, systematize, summarize economic and legal information for use in professional activities, as well as navigate the issues of market economy and entrepreneurship, analyze the phenomena of the legal and economic order and know the organizational and legal forms of entrepreneurial activity.

ON2 Demonstrate knowledge and understanding in the field of history, apply the conceptual apparatus of historical knowledge, compare the levels of socio-political systems, state and legal institutions, economic, social, and cultural processes in the context of general trends in historical development.

ON3 to explain the main facts that characterize the historical dynamics and periodization of the development of world and national history, to develop an understanding of conceptual and theoretical problems, to determine the general and special in the historical process, to identify historical patterns, cause-and-effect relationships, to formulate them independently.

ON4 Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of historical types of civilizations and states, stages of formation and development of state and legal institutions, centers of culture; historical types of nomadism; stages of formation and development of the Eurasian steppe civilization.

ON5 to systematize and evaluate information from historical and contemporary sources, to master the theoretical and methodological foundations of the study of the history of historical science, to analyze the main problems of source studies, to justify the most important historiographical problems of national and world history.

ON6 To know the principles of historical research, to apply general scientific, special historical methods, to possess the technologies of scientific analysis, the methodology of solving research problems; to analyze, synthesize and critically comprehend information based on complex scientific methods; to generalize, systematize empirical material; logically confirm or refute the historical hypothesis of their own research work, to possess the principles of conducting scientific discussion, including in Russian (Kazakh), foreign languages

ON7 to evaluate historical events, facts, personalities in history, the ideological foundations of social and cultural models, to identify the socio-historical conditions for the formation of the system of values of national and world culture, to analyze the specifics of cultural and historical development, to see their relationship and historical continuity, to use the monuments of spiritual history for the interpretation and analysis of socio-political epochs; to evaluate the social purpose of spiritual culture in society, to form a respectful attitude to the traditions, historical identity and spiritual life of society.

ON8 explain and analyze the main stages of the formation and development of a museum, archive, as a socio-cultural institution; own and apply historical and cultural and historical-local history functions in the activities of institutions (archives, museums), organize local history, museum, optional and other activities in an educational institution; demonstrate modern methodology and methods for solving professional problems.

ON9 Possess the skills to implement the tasks of innovative educational policy; formulate and solve problems related to the implementation of organizational and managerial functions, use the methods of the studied sciences for their implementation; possess the methods of applying modern information and communication technologies in the educational process, demonstrate innovative learning technologies in the teaching of historical disciplines, taking into account the transition to the updated content of education, possess the principles and laws of the development of a culture of thinking; possess the techniques of lecturing.

ON10 Demonstrate the ability to independent information and cognitive activity, including the ability to navigate through various sources of historical information, critically evaluate and interpret it; possess the skills of information processing (analysis, synthesis, interpretation, evaluation, argumentation); critical and creative thinking; possess the skills of goal setting, planning, choosing a course of action, control, analyze and adjust their activities; to build logical reasoning, to draw conclusions and conclusions, including in Russian (Kazakh), foreign languages.

ON11 possess the skills of practical use of the knowledge of the basics of pedagogical activity in teaching the course of history, to correlate, analyze and explain the political, socio-cultural, economic factors of historical development, as well as the role of the human factor and the civilizational component in the teaching of historical disciplines.

ON12 To argue their point of view, opinion on controversial and debatable issues of history, based on the main conceptual approaches, historiographical interpretations of current problems of national and world history; to analyze and summarize historical information.

ON13 to understand the logic of the development of national and world history, global processes in their historical conditionality; to apply the theoretical and methodological foundations of the development of historical science; to establish cultural diversity and spiritual heritage.

ON14 Apply knowledge and understanding of the functional features of oral and written professionally-oriented texts, including scientific and technical ones; recognize and use in oral and written statements the main grammatical units characteristic of professional speech; carry out foreign language communication within the framework of professional communication.

In order to create special conditions for people with special educational needs to receive education, the graduate's competence model is supplemented with professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. For this purpose, courses for the formation of the ability of persons with special educational needs to successfully socialize in society and actively adapt to the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease, are introduced into the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor".

2. THE GRADUATE COMPETENCE MODEL

Competence of general education:

- develop the ability to interpersonal social and professional communication in Kazakh, Russian and foreign languages;
- contribute to the development of information literacy through the mastery and use of modern information and communication technologies in all areas of their lives and activities;
- form skills of self-development and education throughout life;
- form a personality capable of mobility in the modern world, critical thinking and physical self-improvement;
- to evaluate the surrounding reality on the basis of worldview positions formed by knowledge of the fundamentals of philosophy, which provide scientific understanding and study of the natural and social world by methods of scientific and philosophical cognition, to reveal the meaning of the content and specific features of the mythological, religious and scientific worldview;
- to show a civic position based on a deep understanding and scientific analysis of the main stages, patterns, peculiarities of the historical development of Kazakhstan, to use methods and techniques of historical description to analyze the causes and consequences of events in the history of Kazakhstan;
- assess situations in various spheres of interpersonal, social and professional communication, taking into account basic knowledge of sociology, political science, cultural studies, psychology, arguing their own assessment of everything happening in the social and industrial spheres, as well as synthesize knowledge of these sciences as a modern product of integrative processes;
- to use scientific methods, methods of research of a specific science, as well as the entire socio-political cluster, to select a methodology, analyze and summarize the results of the study;
- to develop their own moral and civic position on the basis of social, business, cultural, legal and ethical norms of the Kazakh society;
- to put into practice knowledge in the field of social sciences and humanities, which has worldwide recognition, synthesize new knowledge and present it in the form of humanitarian socially significant products;
- to engage in communication in oral and written forms in Kazakh, Russian and foreign languages, using linguistic and speech means based on grammatical knowledge to solve the problems of interpersonal, intercultural and industrial (professional) communication, as well as to analyze information, actions and deeds of communication participants in accordance with the communication situation;
- to use various types of information and communication technologies in personal activities: Internet resources, cloud and mobile services for the search, storage, processing, protection and dissemination of information;

- to build a personal educational trajectory throughout life for self-development and career growth, to focus on a healthy lifestyle to ensure full-fledged social and professional activities through methods and means of physical culture;
- to know and understand the basic laws of the history of Kazakhstan, the basics of philosophical, socio-political, economic and legal knowledge, communication in oral and written forms in Kazakh, Russian and foreign languages;
- apply the acquired knowledge for effective socialization and adaptation in changing socio-cultural conditions, possess the skills of quantitative and qualitative analysis of social phenomena, processes and problems.

- generalize, systematize empirical material; logically confirm or refute the historical hypothesis of one's own research work, possess the principles of conducting scientific discussion
- to know the principles of historical research, to apply general scientific, special historical methods, to possess the technologies of scientific analysis, methods of solving research problems.
- to know the main stages and patterns of development in the history of the Kazakh Khanate, in the context of new conceptual approaches, the stages of formation of the Kazakh nation, socio-economic, political, cultural processes, the political history of the Kazakh Khanate, the role and place of the Kazakh people in the system of nomadic civilization.

- analyze the main problems of source studies, substantiate the most important historiographical problems of national and world history.
- possess skills: independently choose information from sources; own methods of developing tasks related to professional activity, make group decisions based on group discussion.
- to work with various sources of local history and museological information, independently acquire knowledge; to use museum terminology correctly.

- apply and process, store information, as well as use modern information and communication technologies and programming to solve practical problems;
- be able to identify the main aspects of pedagogical activity; scientifically analyze socially significant problems and processes.
