## 1. Explanatory note of the educational program 6B01510 - "Geography-history"

The modular educational program (MEP) is compiled on the basis of:

- State standard of higher and postgraduate education, approved by Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;
- Rules for organizing the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;
- Model rules for the activities of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;
- Professional standard "Teacher", approved by the order of the acting Minister of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 500 dated December 15, 2022;
- Structures of a modular educational program (Form No. 26, revision No. 3 of 10/08/2021).

The modules of the OOD block (OK 51 credits) and the university component (VC) - 5 credits, include disciplines common to all educational programs, during the study of which the graduate must master the following knowledge of the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal, economic, environmental fundamentals, as well as cultural and historical values, the fundamentals of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, knowledge of information about the political life of the country.

The DB block includes disciplines of the university component (UC) - 41 credits and elective components (AC) - 71 credits. Modules of these disciplines form scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills in the field of geography and history.

The PD block includes disciplines of the university component (UC) - 30 credits and elective components (AC) - 34 credits. The modules of these disciplines allow the formation of a complex of key and special knowledge acquired by the graduate about professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve geographical and historical problems, for the successful solution of problems.

The criterion for completing the educational process is that the student has completed 232 credits of theoretical training and 8 credits of final certification. The MOS consists of 21 modules.

The goal of the modular educational program 6B01510 Geography-History is to train highly qualified personnel with professional knowledge, skills and abilities in the field of education based on the formation of general cultural and professional competencies, a teacher's personality capable of ensuring the effectiveness of the educational process based on classical and innovative teaching methods, a personality capable of professional growth and professional mobility in the new conditions of educational practice.
