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1.EXPLANATORY NOTE

The modular educational program (MOE) is compiled in accordance with the following regulatory documents:

- The Law of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On Education" dated 27.07.2007 with additions and amendments dated 01.07.2023;
- State standard of Higher and Postgraduate education, approved by the Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 2 dated July 20, 2022;
- Rules for the organization of the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by Order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 152 dated April 20, 2011 (as amended by Order of the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan No. 563 dated 12.10.2018);
- Standard rules for the activities of educational organizations implementing educational programs of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan RK No. 595 dated 30.10.2018;
- -Professional standard "Teacher", Approved by the order of the Acting Minister of Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated December 15, 2022 No. 500.
 - -Form 26 "Structure of the modular educational program.

The modular educational program is designed as a set of consecutive training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary for awarding the academic degree of Bachelor of Education under the educational program 6B01732 "Russian language and literature in schools with a non-Russian language of instruction".

The modules of the block of general education disciplines (OOD) (a total of 56 credits, of which OK (mandatory component) - 51 credits, KV (optional component) - 5 credits) include disciplines common to all educational programs, in the study of which the graduate must master the competence of general education, which is aimed at knowledge of the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal foundations, as well as cultural and historical values, the basics of computer science, language communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, possession of information about the political life of the country.

The block of basic disciplines (DB) (112 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (VC - 39 credits) and elective components (CV - 73 credits). Modules of these disciplines form general professional competencies aimed at developing basic and professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills and skills in theoretical and branch sciences in the field of education.

The block of core disciplines of PD (64 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (VC - 30 credits) and elective components (CV - 34 credits). Modules of these disciplines allow graduates to form special competencies aimed at the formation of professional qualities, including theoretical and empirical knowledge, as well as skills for practical actions, the ability to analyze and solve pedagogical problems of a theoretical and practical nature in the field of education and upbringing.

Additional types of training (DVO) include final certification.

The criterion for the completion of the educational process is the student's mastering 240 credits, of which 232 credits of theoretical training and 8 credits are final certification.

The MOS consists of 20 modules.

Russian Russian Language and Literature in schools with a non–Russian language of instruction" educational program 6B01732 aims to train competitive specialists - teachers of Russian language and literature with fundamental knowledge, skills and competencies in the field of pedagogy, psychology, teaching methods of Russian language and literature, necessary in professional activities at a level recognized by the international community, and meeting the needs of societies of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

Expected results of the educational program:

ON 1: Plan, design and conduct training sessions in the Russian language and literature, integrating knowledge from various subject areas in solving pedagogical problems, draw up lesson plans, develop educational and didactic materials and training programs in the Russian language and literature, taking into account the characteristics and needs of students using traditional, innovative, information and communication technologies, as well as new achievements in the field of psychological and pedagogical sciences;

ON2: To form and develop the language, communicative, information, professional competencies of students; know the functional features of oral and written professionally oriented texts, including those of a scientific and technical nature; recognize and use in oral and written statements the basic grammatical units characteristic of professional speech; to carry out foreign language communication within the framework of professional communication.

ON3: To carry out the educational process, observing the pedagogical tact and create a favorable educational environment that helps to strengthen the feeling of patriotism, the formation of a tolerant attitude of students to a different culture, to the democratic values of modern society.

ON4: Demonstrate fundamental, systemic knowledge in the field of linguistics and the modern Russian language in synchronous, diachronic and practical aspects, the terminological base of linguistics; be aware of the diversity of language varieties (literary language, dialects, vernacular, colloquial speech) and competently analyze modern linguistic facts from the standpoint of phonetics, lexicology, stylistics and grammar;

ON5: Apply the skills of conducting a constructive dialogue that meets the standards of the modern Russian literary language, communication in a multicultural, multi-ethnic and multi-confessional society using the real life experience of students;

ON 10: Own a system of subject, psychological, pedagogical and methodological knowledge, implement them in professional activities, be capable of generating new pedagogical ideas, of critical thinking; develop current educational and organizational documentation (didactic, control and measuring materials, etc.), possess organizational skills, show high executive discipline.

ON 11: Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the language as a historical phenomenon, comment on the facts of the modern Russian language from the perspective of a diachronic approach;
