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1. Explanatory note of the modular educational program 6B01101 - «Pedagogy and psychology»

The modular educational program (MEP) is compiled on the basis of the following regulatory documents:

- State standard of higher and postgraduate education, approved by Order of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated July 20, 2022 No. 2;

- Rules for organizing the educational process on credit technology of education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated April 20, 2011 No. 152;

- Model rules for the activities of organizations of higher and (or) postgraduate education, approved by order of the Minister of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan dated October 30, 2018 No. 595;

- Professional standard "Teacher", approved by order of the Deputy Chairman of the Board of the National Chamber of Entrepreneurs of the Republic of Kazakhstan "Atameken" on December 15, 2022 No. 500.

The MEP is developed as a set of sequential training modules for the entire period of study and is aimed at mastering the competencies necessary to award a Bachelor of Education degree in the educational program 6B01101 – Pedagogy and Psychology.

The modules of the block of general education disciplines (GED) (total 56 credits, OK-51, VK-5) include disciplines common to all educational programs, in the study of which the graduate must master the following competencies: knowledge of the laws of development of society and its socio-political, legal, as well as cultural and historical values, the fundamentals of computer science, linguistic communication and understanding of the principles of a healthy lifestyle, knowledge of human psychology, possession of information about the political life of the country,

The block of basic disciplines (BD) (112 credits in total) includes disciplines of the university component (VC) - 37 credits and elective components (AC) - 75 credits. The modules of these disciplines form a set of competencies: the formation of professional qualities, covering deep scientific, theoretical and methodological knowledge, practical skills in historical, theoretical and branch sciences in the field of psychology.

The block of major disciplines (PD) includes disciplines of the university component (VC) - 30 credits and elective components (AC) - 34 credits. Total - 64 credits.

The criterion for completing the educational process is that the student has completed at least 240 credits, of which 232 credits are theoretical training and 8 are final certification.

The MOS consists of 23 modules.

When discussing the MEP, the social partners noted that the content of the EP quite fully reflects the necessary competencies of future educational psychologists. Social partners who took part in the discussion of the MOP: Kenzhebaeva A.S. – Director of KSU SOSL No. 38, Akhmetkaliev N.N. Director of KSU Secondary School No. 3; Zhuanyshev K.A. director of KSU Secondary School No. 42 with a boarding school; Mirsaitova A.D. - Director of Secondary School No. 30.

The goal is to train qualified educational psychologists, adapted to the changing requirements of the labor market and capable of providing psychological and pedagogical support to subjects of the educational process of educational institutions of various types, subjects of social and specialized organizations.

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Expected results of the educational program:

ON 1. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding in the field of development of domestic and foreign pedagogical science, summarize advanced pedagogical experience based on modern achievements in the field of study

ON 2. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding in practical teaching activities in the secondary education system with developed professional competencies in managing educational systems in the social and legal spheres

ON 3. Apply knowledge and understanding of facts and phenomena in various areas of psychological and pedagogical science, effectively apply methods of psychological diagnostics, correction and therapy in the activities of a teacher-psychologist;

ON 4. Apply knowledge, the basic principles of psychological and psychophysiological concepts of development in ontogenesis, know the main stages of the evolution of the human and animal psyche

ON 5. Apply knowledge and understanding at a professional level to classify developmental disorders, as well as develop an algorithm for professional actions in working with children with various developmental and behavioral characteristics

ON 6. Collect and interpret information for psychological research, develop the ability to recognize and evaluate psychologically dangerous and harmful factors for a person, determine ways of psychological protection against them, as well as study hypotheses and proposals about the nature and mechanisms of personality

ON 7. Demonstrate knowledge and understanding in the field of development of domestic and foreign psychological and pedagogical science, summarize advanced pedagogical experience, taking into account ethnocultural and modern achievements in the field of study.

ON 8. Apply theoretical and practical knowledge to solve educational and practical problems in the use of teaching methods, techniques and technologies in the practical activities of a teacher.

ON 9. Apply theoretical and practical knowledge to solve educational, practical and professional problems in the field of communication, taking into account multilingualism.

ON 10. Apply various types of psychological techniques in the theory and practice of individual, group and family therapy.

ON 11. Systematize scientific knowledge in the field of individual differences in the psyche, individuals and groups of people, use methods of scientific and

psychological research in practical activities, as well as search, analyze and synthesize information, apply a systematic approach to solve assigned problems

ON 12. Collect and interpret information to form judgments about students' professional self-determination, determine the structure and levels of intellectual development, and use learning skills for professional self-determination.

ON 13. Demonstrate knowledge of the ideas of a modern rule of law to instill skills in entrepreneurship, leadership, and receptiveness to innovation based on scientific research while maintaining the principles of academic integrity, as well as ensuring safety standards.

To create special conditions for receiving education by persons with special educational needs, the competency-based graduate model is supplemented with professional competencies that ensure the adaptive nature of the main educational program. For this purpose, the catalog of courses of the additional educational program "Minor" includes courses to develop in persons with special educational needs the ability for successful socialization in society and active adaptation in the labor market, taking into account the characteristics of the disease

- show a civic position based on a deep understanding and scientific analysis of the main stages, patterns, uniqueness of the historical development of Kazakhstan, use methods and techniques of historical description to analyze the causes and consequences of events in the history of Kazakhstan;

- assess situations in various spheres of interpersonal, social and professional communication, taking into account basic knowledge of sociology, political science, cultural studies, psychology, arguing for your own assessment of everything that happens in the social and industrial spheres, as well as synthesize the knowledge of these sciences as a modern product of integrative processes;

- use scientific methods, research techniques for a specific science, as well as the entire socio-political cluster, select methodology, analysis and summarize the research results;

- develop one's own moral and civic position on the basis of social, business, cultural, legal and ethical norms of Kazakhstani society;

- apply in practice knowledge in the field of social sciences and humanities, which has worldwide recognition, synthesize new knowledge and present it in the form of humanitarian, socially significant products;

- engage in communication in oral and written forms in Kazakh, Russian and foreign languages, using linguistic and speech means based on grammatical knowledge to solve problems of interpersonal, intercultural and industrial (professional) communication, as well as analyze information, actions and actions of communication participants in according to the communication;

- use various types of information and communication technologies in personal activities: Internet resources, cloud and mobile services for searching, storing, processing, protecting and distributing information;

- build a personal educational trajectory throughout life for self-development and career growth, focus on a healthy lifestyle to ensure full-fledged social and professional activity through methods and means of physical culture;

- make a psychological and pedagogical assessment of the student's individual abilities and capabilities, taking into account existing difficulties;
- determine the level of educational motivation of students and pupils;
- prepare and compile an individual portfolio of students and pupils;
- draw up individual support programs in overcoming difficulties in the learning or development of the student;
- know the criteria for the effectiveness of the educational environment of an educational organization;
- know the criteria and forms of destructive communities;
- organize and conduct scientific and methodological work;
- prepare, conduct and participate in scientific and methodological events in educational organizations and beyond;
- improve the psychological and pedagogical competencies of participants in the educational process;

- organize methodological material to create comfortable conditions for the educational environment and improve the psychological and pedagogical culture of the educational organization.

- requirements for psychological and pedagogical interpretation and formalization of justifications for the obtained diagnostic results for the training, development and education of students;
- regulatory legal acts relating to the education system and the implementation of psychological and pedagogical activities;

- methods for assessing the comfort and psychological safety of the educational environment;
- scientific and methodological principles of pedagogical and developmental psychology in the pedagogical practice of organizing the educational process;
- conduct psychological and pedagogical monitoring and analysis of effectiveness in the use of methods and means of educational activities;
- inform teachers of educational organizations in order to improve psychological and pedagogical competencies and the quality of the conditions of the educational environment;
- drawing up an expert opinion on the quality and content of the educational environment;
- know the basics of pedagogical, age, general, special, family psychology, developmental and personality psychology, counseling psychology, pathopsychology;
- scientific and methodological principles of psychological and pedagogical support of educational activities;
- methods and technologies for organizing and conducting research activities;
- determine educational objectives for conducting research activities;
- select the necessary research methods;
- make strategic decisions in favor of providing effective assistance.
