Part 1 of the calendar plan Organization of expeditions, work with manuscripts in archival collections	1 August - 15 November 2024	<p>Expeditionary work in the districts of the Abay region to collect folklore heritage was organized. According to this section of the calendar plan, the project manager K. T. Tulebaeva and the project researchers Zh. Zh. Aitova, G. T. Abikenova, F. A. Gainullina, A. A. Kasymova, K. A. Aubakirova, A. M. Mamyrbekov, S. E. Mubarakova, A. B. Abdullinva, A. K. Asylbekova went on a business trip with expeditionary work to the Ayagoz, Makanshinsky, Urzharsky districts from October 15 to 18, and to the Beskaragaysky, Borodulikha districts from October 23 to 24. As a result, work was carried out in the departments of culture and in the library collections of the districts. Cultural monuments in the districts include the Kozy Korpesh-Bayan Sulu mausoleum, the Shynkozha Batyr monument, the Urzhar Khanshaymy monument, the balbal stones found on Mount Tarbagatai, and the Bi-Boranbay mausoleum, where the folklore heritage of elders is collected. Expeditionary work on this section will be continued in other areas of the Abay region.</p>	<p>The anthology collection “Folklore of the Abai Region” uses information collected from library and archival sources.</p> <p>The information collected during the expedition will be used to write scientific articles.</p>

Part 2 of the calendar plan Conducting an analysis of collected scientific research	1 August - 15 November 2024	<p>The work was carried out with manuscript collections and collections in libraries and research centers of Almaty, Kazakhstan. As part of this section of the calendar plan, from November 12 to 16, project participant G. T. Abikenova familiarized herself with materials on the topic of the project from the Dissertation Department and the Rare Books and Manuscripts Fund of the National Library in Alma-Ata. In order to study the work of poets and writers of the Abai region in accordance with new scientific paradigms in literature, theoretical materials of the library fund related to the synergetic method of literary research were studied. He familiarized himself with the latest studies of the work of Abai and Shakarim from the collection of rare books and manuscripts of the National Library. As a result, an article on the topic "The Image of Great People in Shakarim's Poems" was prepared and presented at the international scientific conference "Shakarimov Readings".</p> <p>From November 15 to 23, 2024, the project manager K.T. Tolebaeva and the project researchers Zh.Zh. Aitova, F.A. Gainullina, G.B. Kozhakhmetova worked in the phonoarchival and folklore fund (rare manuscript fund) of the Pushkin House in St.</p>	

		<p>Petersburg, Russian Federation, and in the fund of the Russian National Library.</p> <p>The results obtained during the study were presented as scientific articles in a domestic publication recommended by the State Committee on History and Folklore of the city of Semey, and manuscript versions of articles on the topics of “The appearance of the city of Semey in Kazakh literature” and “Study of the works of Abai and Shakarim using a synergetic method” were prepared and sent to the Bulletin of the University named after Sh.
